Dear Parent,

One of our boarders of class VII reported to school with fever and he was sent home immediately.

Screening and tests were conducted on him, in his home town, which proved positive for swine flu.

He is being treated in his home town and there has been no untoward incident.

Keeping this in mind, and as a precaution, we have decided to close school from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> of October to Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> of November.(10 days)

**You are advised to get your child / children properly checked by a Registered Medical Practitioner and report to school with the Medical Certificate on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November before 5.30 p.m. (Avoid reporting, Thursday morning, as it would put us to a lot of inconvenience.**

**Reporting on Wednesday is subject to your child / children being free from symptoms of fever, running nose, cold, cough, throat infection and joint pain. Advise your children to carry and use a handkerchief or tissue paper. Please provide them with Dettol hand wash.**

**While at home take precautions not to send them shopping, for movies or to play with their friends. This is the time for them to rest, revise and to keep good health.**

**Class X students are advised to revise and prepare for a series of tests in all subjects on portions that have been completed so far, as soon as they return.**
